An ancestral tradition of this tribe is to kill lions to prove their strengh. Now they belong to our cause.

Our organisation supports the local population because we think that they shouldn't be bypassed, it shows us that all can change for the best.

As well we take care of the Kenyan shore and its endangered wildlife. We denounce mass-tourism which is an environmental disaster and we fight for a sustainable tourism.



Shores clean up

For the past few years, the amount of washed up litter spoiling Kenyan landscapes has been critically increasing. In 2017, a Kenyan family decided to take action, in order to solve this main issue, by creating our association. Twice a month we organise trash pickups, seeking for new sites to be cleaned up on each operation. We sort out waste afterwards to recycle it properly. During the previous year, we have collected altogether 8 000 pounds of trash. This helpful gesture has allowed to rehabilitate beaches as threatened as Takaungu was to give Kenya back its heavenly coastline back.

Plastic bottles challenge

In November 2019, our company had challenged Kenyan inhabitants: we asked them to collect plastic bottlesin order to recycle them. At least 2 000 000 bottles have been collected! The goal was to make people aware of this pollutant, and to make sure they don't throw away their wastes in the streets, especially plastic bottles. People get 1 US \$, when they bring back 20 bottles. That way it encourages people to clean the beach because they want to earn more money. This initiative is such an important project that it has already reduced the amount of plastics on the beach. Furthermorethis program helped us to aggregate a huge quantity of plastics andit allowed us to make cheap recycled wheelchairs. The project "plastics bottles challenge" has been a successful share for 17 months now! Indeed we were

Before this foundation, many animals that brought tourists to savanna are endangered and poached, poaching is widespread in Kenya.
So, we aim to protect these animals from poaching and employ Maasai.
Animals' protecting is our goal. The monitoring of animals in Kenya is our priority. During our projects, we were able to collaborate with many animal protection professionals to improve our procedures.
We employed Kenyans to help us in Savannah. And thanks to their great knowledge of flora and fauna, we have intervened for the animals about fifty times.

OUR PROJECT

Our projects which are important to us are two very impressive and unfortunately very violent projects. The first project we worked on is a family of lions. This family was being hunted by the Maasai and we protected the lions from them. When we found them two lion cubs were running away and their parents were very badly injured. By protecting some Maasai, we saw that we can live with wild animals. And that's how we got the idea for this association, and it was later invented. And the project that struck us the most was the time we rescued albino giraffes from the hands of poachers. The poachers were chasing them and if they had succeeded they would

have butchered them and stole their furs.

WHO WE ARE



The mission of our organization, Unitadhi pari, is to conserve wildlife, epecifically the turtles. Our organization has been created in 2005 in order to save turties. The most of us are valunteers and local Inhabitant.



Preserving the natural habitat of turtles in Kenya is crucial. The turties are endangers by mass tourism and

taurist resorts. Litter pallutes the sea and these are eating by turties, which die afterwards. Taday, six of the seven living species are treated as threatened or critically endangered.

The valunteers of the association callect plastic trash so as to recycle it afterwards into objects, in order to limit the amount of waste on the beaches and the coats, which threatens wildlife and therefore the turtles.

Furthermore, packers can kill turties for their shells, so we supervise 2 or 3 nights a week the caasts of the beaches most popular with paachers.



We argunize clean walks an different beaches since 2006. During these clean walks, we picked up hundreds or thousands kilograms of litters that we sent to a campany. This campany recycle trash to turn them into decoration, musical instruments, fashion clothes, and so many other things. In 2010, we signed a petition to banish the bright lights of the resorts, that face the beaches and can confuse nesting turtles. Naw, we try to sensitize tourists and Kenyan population, because if everybody make efforts that will limit the extinction of turtle species.
